Maps are based on the latest Ordnance Survey data which councils can access for free via the Public Sector Geospatial Agreement (PSGA).

Learn how Pear's maps can work with 3rd party software such as AdvantEDGE and InspectEDGE, and provide the public with the ability via the council website to search the cemetery map(s) when the maps are powered by Epitaph.
